As you might already have deduced this is a Hundred Dollar Bill Switch using a Mis made Bill in lieu of the Hundred. Many of you in fact might already be doing this exact effect as it is something of a no brainer and one of the reasons the mis made for bill was created for in the first place.

Those of you who never contemplated using their Mismade bill in this fashion and are happy with their particular version of the Hundred Dollar Bill Switch might be thinking that they need not purchase this DVD nor read this review any further. But they'd be wrong. Mr. Balay's version of the bill switch is a very useful addition to anyone's arsenal. Even if you've already mastered the classic version.

Mr. Balay's switch is easy to learn, avoids some of the potential fumbling points of the original Mike Kozlowski\Milton Nichols\Vladimir "Vlado" Vladimirov version and will potentially fry those in the know. The instructions on the DVD are clear and easy to follow and with a modicum of effort one should be doing this like a pro after a few days of diligent practice.

Mr. Balay's technique as it most likely cleaner and faster than the one you are currently using. Over the years he's carefully honed and improved his version of the switch by using it amaze both magicians and laymen alike while working behind the counter at Fantasma Magic in New York City.

So do yourself a favor and take this opportunity to add this version of the classic bill switch to your performing arsenal.

### April's Meeting Report of the Northwest Ring of Fire Magic Club #339

The "Three of Clubs" convention is still on hold by the Canadians. We are keeping informed and will let everyone know if it is on for this year.

There were some questions about what to learn in card magic. Some books were suggested for reading. Payne gave a teach in on the Top change, spread pass, Elmsley count, Jordan count. He also taught how to do "Twisting the Aces" Monty Reed showed the club a card routine on which he is working. The routine is based on the "Alpha Deck" Payne showed a Star Wars trick. He had two replica of a lightsaber handle that he had 3D printed and a balloon pump that look like R2D2. He blew up a balloon and placed inside the lightsaber handle, next small thin sharp swords penetrated the handle without bursting the balloon.

Payne brought out a small box, inside the box was a coin and he demonstrated that when the box was closed the coin couldn't move or tilt. He closed the lid then penetrated the box and the coin with three small swords. Payne held up two cards in one hand, the cards forming a X. He shakes his hand and the two cards become one with the pattern on the cards become a swirl pattern. Dan Harlan's "Vortex"

James Donahue had some items for show and tell. He had a deck of playing cards that had had drawn picture of the Magic Castle on them. James also had with him the book Gazzo's "Read Between the Lines". He also had "Gaff Lighter Project" book with stickers inside that you can use to convert Bic Lighters for paddle move routines.

James had two cards chosen and place on mat, two kept changing places then at the end became blanks.

James showed us a ring the ring then stretched to a large size, then shrink to a small than normal size, then returned to the original size. Based on "Bandwidth" by Gregory Wilson. James also performed his take of "Chinese Challenge Coins" routine

Tony Blei removes five coins from a box and proceeded to perform a coin routine where each of the coins magically return to the box.

Rich Waters showed us another card deck from his collection. This was from the Museum of Musical Instruments and each suite is a type (woodwinds, brass, percussion, strings) and the individual cards are the instruments with information and history of each. Rich performed a routine where he asked for the spectator's birthdate, deal the cards face down to the month and use that card to find the selected card.
